On a personal note, I've appreciated the flexibility UCP has given me to work around the schedules of my own growing boys.

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
MEREDITH GILL

I have learned that Early Intervention is a delicate balance of knowledge and always continuing to learn and grow. Just because you have expertise in a certain area of development and you feel there is a right way of doing things, that does not mean that every family is going to think like you or do things the way you think they should be done. You need to meet a family where they are, remember you are in their home, and you need to work within their routines and honor their ways of doing things. In other words, you may sometimes need to change what you think you know.

"I especially love when families that I have worked with in the past reach out to share what the kids are doing now. Families send me videos, pictures, texts with messages like 'Remember when we were working on this? Check him out now!' The job itself is its own reward."
