When – Sunday November 7, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. (times will vary depending on assigned role)

Where –City Island- 245 Championship Way Harrisburg, PA 17101

Who – Upon arrival volunteers are to meet All Community Events crew underneath the red registration tents.

Job Descriptions

Registration assistant – Volunteers will help with the process of participants checking in. They will check if the participant is registered by last name and then give them their race materials. Some volunteers will also assist with the process of new participants signing up the day of the race.

Post-race registration/food – Once registration is closed the tents will be used for food primarily. Volunteers will help organize the food and monitor it while participants are finishing. Event gear exchanging will also be going on. Participants will be asking to exchange their gear for a different size, and at this time it is okay as long as they didn't run in it.

Mug/Hot Apple Cider/Caramel Apple Distribution- Each participant will have a mug, hot apple cider, and a caramel apple waiting for them at the finish line. Volunteers will help set up and distribute the items.

Course Marshal – Course marshals will be placed on the course (in pairs of 2) and help direct the participants, so they run the correct way. Here we ask the volunteers to be as enthusiastic as possible encouraging the runners to have a good time.

Water Station – Volunteers assigned to the water station will fill up cups of water and help distribute them to passing participants.

*Volunteers will more than likely work more than one job throughout the event.

- Please dress appropriately for the weather. Check the forecast prior to arrival of the event.
