I stay at UCP because....

I happened upon UCP almost by accident. I have stayed because I adored spending time with the individuals I work with. During my time here, I haven't felt like I was just an employee, but also a friend, a confidant, and an advocate; something particular to this kind of work. At CPS, it's exciting to see one of the participants get excited about something new they did or a new place they visited. Witnessing changes in their interests and skills is rewarding.
